Any guidance you can offer your child to prepare for their turn would be appreciated. Our topics this term relate to our science unit "On the Move" and our Farm excursion.

SPEAKING & LISTENING TOPICS KINDERGARTEN TERM 2	
<u>Week 1</u> Boys Week beginning Tuesday 1 st May Girls week beginning Monday 7 th May	Children can recount some event/s from the holiday. The children will be guided towards telling their news relating to these questions: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Who was the news about?• What happened?• Where did it happen?• When did it happen?• How did you/ others feel about it?
<u>Week 3</u> Boys Week beginning Monday 14 th May Girls week beginning Monday 21 st May	Find a toy that moves in some way. Explain what part of the toy moves and how it moves e.g. a toy car – the wheels go round. It moves because I push it along.
<u>Week 5</u> Boys week beginning Monday 28 th May Girls week beginning Monday 4 th June	How do people move? Talk about different ways people can move e.g. swing arms, jump on the spot. Demonstrate SAFELY, 4 different ways you can move.
<u>Week 7</u> Boys week beginning Monday 11 th June Girls week beginning Monday 18 th June	Find an object around the house that rolls. Bring it to school and demonstrate how it rolls. Tell what makes it roll and what the shape is. e.g. a rolling pin rolls because it is round.
<u>Week 9</u> Boys week beginning Monday 25 th June Girls week beginning Monday 2 nd July	What is your favourite farm animal and why? Describe the animal, what does it eat, where does it live, how does it help us? e.g. a cow gives us milk.
