

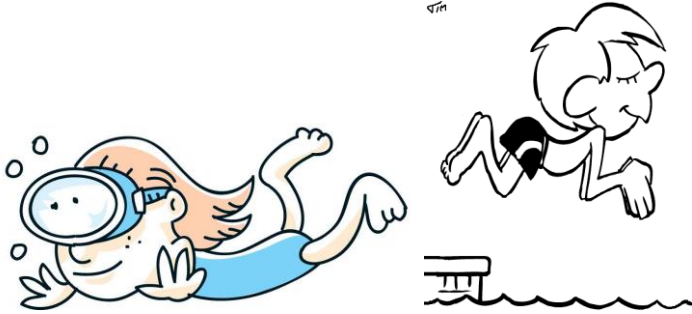
Stage 2 News

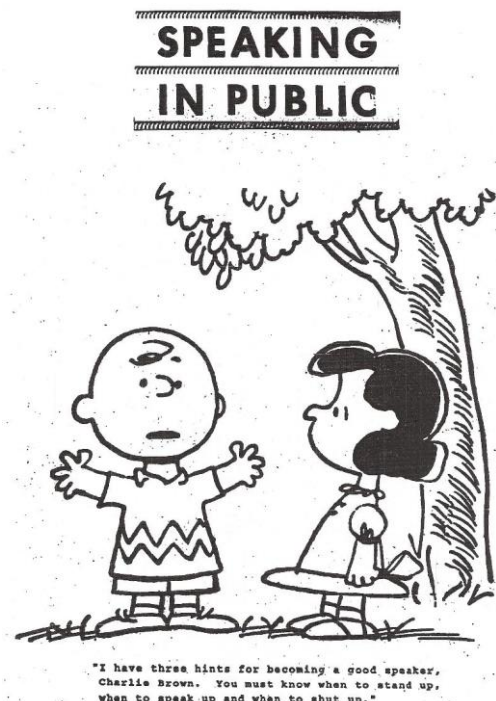
